ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- Have attained the age of 18 years or over
- English language competence can also be demonstrated through documented evidence of any of the following:
- Educated for 5 years in an English-speaking country; or
- Successful completion of an English Placement Test

COURSE DURATION

This qualification will be delivered over 104 weeks, including 80 weeks of training and assessment spread over 8 terms of 10 weeks each and 24 weeks of holidays.

- Class sessions: 20 hours per week
- Please note, to complete your course, you will need to have access to a computer and internet. New Era Institute encourages students to bring their own devices to the campus (where there is free wireless internet access).

LOCATION

Classroom sessions will be delivered at both campuses: Sydney CBD and Windsor (Regional NSW).

ASSESSMENT METHODS

All units of competence may be assessed using a selection of tools as mentioned below:

- Written Questions
- Theory assessments Case Study/ Project Work
- Practical assessment (Simulated Environment)

CREDIT TRANSFER/RECOGNITION OF PRIOR LEARNING

Students can apply for course credit upon enrolment into the course. All students are provided with the opportunity to have their prior learning and experience assessed against current standards and gain recognition for this (Recognition of Prior Learning – RPL).

Students who have successfully completed whole units of competency included in this course can apply for Credit. Students who are granted RPL and/ or Credit will have their course delivery and assessment schedule altered and may also be eligible for reduced fees.

FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

If RPL/credit transfer is approved, the student's COE will be adjusted to reflect any reduction in the period of study the student is enrolled in. The study load will remain the scheduled 20 hours per week as per your visa requirements.

EXIT POINT AND PATHWAYS

Students must complete all assessments for each unit of competency to be deemed competent in a unit. All 8 units must be completed to gain the full qualification.

Students who do not complete the full qualification will receive a Statement of Attainment for all unit successfully completed.
