Credit Transfer/Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL)

Students can apply for recognition of their existing skills and knowledge that are relevant to the units of competency within the course. These skills and knowledge may have been obtained through workplace training or experience and may reduce the number of units required to be completed during the course.

Students who have successfully completed whole units of competency included in this course can apply for Credit. Students who are granted RPL and/or Credit will have their course delivery and assessment schedule altered and may also be eligible for reduced fees.

For International Students:

When RPL/credit transfer is approved, the student's Confirmation of Enrolment (COE) will be adjusted to reflect any reduction in the period of study the student is enrolled in. The study load will remain the scheduled 20 hours per week as per the student visa requirements.
